 - ▶ DELIVERANCE is the opportunity to assist the Beloved in stripping off all the things that cover the beautiful scroll written for them in heaven.

- ▶ To see hindrances drop to the ground.


WHAT IS DELIVERANCE?, CONT.

 - ▶ Deliverance is letting the Blood of the Redeemer move through your blood and spirit and allow His Spirit cleanse you.

FREEMASONRY

When you look at the symbolism of each level of Freemasonry, you will see a well-thought-out and thorough system designed to capture the spirit, soul and body of a person, as well as to gain control of their identity, destiny and value.



FREEMASONRY

- ▶ Each step of the ceremony requires the person to relinquish part of who they are to Freemasonry.
 - ▶ Repenting and renouncing does not restore what was lost in the ceremony.
 - ▶ Reclaiming what was relinquished allows a person to submit to God and resist the devil more effectively.

EFFECTS OF FREEMASONRY ON IDENTITY, WORTH AND DESTINY

1. Removal Of Clothing

- ▶ Clothing is linked to identity. The person is stripped of their identity and given a new identity - pajamas.
 - ▶ Not for going out - passive, sleep
 - ▶ Later, they are given garments which identify them as Masons.

EFFECTS OF FREEMASONRY

2. Removal Of All Valuables

- money, keys, rings and other jewelry
 - ▶ These have to do with a person's value, both personal and material. Their God-given intrinsic worth and value as a person is lost. Their personal value now comes from how valuable they are to Freemasonry.

EFFECTS OF FREEMASONRY

3. Slipshod Slipper & Checkerboard

- ▶ The right foot has a slipper put on it, designed to make their walk slippery. Their path is not clear, but a mixture of darkness and light. Their ability to find the path for their life and fulfill their destiny becomes uncertain.

EFFECTS ON THE SOUL

4. Hoodwink

- ▶ Head is covered, intellect - mind is surrendered to Freemasonry.

5. Cable Tow

- ▶ Person is bound and led by someone else - free will is surrendered to Freemasonry.



EFFECTS ON THE SOUL

6. Dagger To Left Breast

- ▶ Heart, the seat of emotion, is exposed and submitted to Freemasonry.
 - ▶ All elements of the soul, mind, emotion and will are surrendered to Freemasonry.

EFFECTS OF FREEMASONRY ON THE BODY

7. Vows, Oaths and Curses Spoken Against The Body

- ▶ All internal organs, endocrine and immune systems, the reproductive system, the eyes, brain, ears, tongue and all extremities.

EFFECTS OF FREEMASONRY ON THE SPIRIT

8. Seeking The Light Of Freemasonry

- ▶ This statement submits the spirit of the person to the deception of Freemasonry. Spiritual discernment is lost. A spirit that opposes the Holy Spirit is given preeminence. The person is captured in false worship and is deceived into believing that it is worship of the true God.

EFFECTS ON THE SPIRIT

The stated purpose of the first degree is to conceal the “higher truths” from initiates.

Not until they have gone further are they introduced to the worship of Greek, Hindu, Norse and Egyptian gods. By committing their spirit to the light of Freemasonry, they have committed to all of this.



EFFECTS OF FREEMASONRY ON HEALTH


If you worship the gods of Egypt, you will get the diseases of Egypt.

HISTORY & STRUCTURE

Freemasonry includes 33 Degrees, the most common of which are the first three.



FREEMASONS HISTORY

- ▶ Originally a “builders guild”, stonecutters for the construction of buildings - especially religious ones: Churches & Cathedrals, Mosques, Pagodas & Temples
- ▶ Oldest surviving written constitution is 1480.
- ▶ Evidence back to 1150 AD or before...
- ▶ First Grand Masonic Lodge established in London in 1717 AD.



CONFLICT WITH CHRISTIANITY

- The Name of Jesus is not to be spoken in the Lodge
- ALL religions are “on the (same) level” or equally inspired.



WHY JOIN THE LODGE?

- ▶ **Masonic Philosophy.** Many Masons are noted through history as great men – its philosophy is very attractive.
- ▶ **Strong Ties with other men.** A sense of camaraderie with Masonic “Brothers”.
- ▶ **Business Connections:** Masons will more likely do business with other masons..
- ▶ **Political & Spiritual Powers:** Masons hold considerable power worldwide, and positions of power in government and military are awarded to brother masons.
- ▶ **Social Power:** The ability to have a public and media voice.
- ▶ **Sense of Pride:** Learning secrets and having special knowledge that the rest of the public does not have.

THE GOD OF FREEMASONRY

▶ **GAOTU** : The “Great Architect of the Universe”

▶ **JAH-BUL-ON** : The Sacred word of the Royal Arch

Jah – For Yahweh (of the Bible)
Bul or Baal – Syriac for “Lord”
On – Egyptian deity Osiris

▶ **LUCIFER – Light-Bearer**: The god of this world who brings “light” to freemasons. Only known to about 5% of freemasons (>level 30).

▶ **THE ALL-SEEING EYE**. An important symbol of the Supreme Being, borrowed by the Freemasons from the nations of antiquity.





FREEMASONRY AND THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA

- **Recognition**—Venturers' achievements are recognized through the Venturing advancement program and through the acknowledgement of a youth's competence and ability by peers and adults.
- **Ideals**—Venturers are expected to know and live by the Venturing Oath and Code. They promise to be faithful in their religious duties, to treasure their American heritage, to help others, and to seek truth and fairness.
- **High Adventure**—Venturing's emphasis on high adventure helps provide team-building opportunities, new meaningful experiences, practical leadership application, and lifelong memories to young adults.
- **Teaching Others**—All of the Venturing awards require Venturers to teach what they have learned to others.

ADVANTAGES FOR MASONIC LODGES

- Scouting provides mentoring opportunities for lodge members.
- Scouting offers program opportunities that attract youth and their families.
- Scouting offers ready-made programs to augment the work of DeMolay.
- Scouting has age-appropriate programs for boys 7 through 17 years of age and young men and women 14 through 20 years of age.
- Scout units have an obligation for service to their chartering organizations.
- Scouting provides a time-tested, high quality developmental youth program that has continuous identification with the Masonic Lodge.
- Scouting offers the use of its program and support facilities, as well as the experience of trained volunteer and professional staff.

- Scouting offers additional challenges and personal growth opportunities through its advancement program.
- Chartering a Scout unit provides greater public awareness of the objectives and mission of Masonry.

ORGANIZING A SCOUTING UNIT

1. Lodge leaders are informed about Scouting.
2. Lodge leaders agree on the desirability of organizing a Scouting unit.
3. The Worshipful Master appoints a chartered organization representative.
4. The chartered organization representative appoints an organizing committee of lodge members, local parents, and other interested adults.
5. An orientation session is held with prospective Scouts and their parents.
6. The organizing committee identifies and recruits unit leaders and committee members.
7. The leaders are trained in program planning (Fast Start training).
8. The program is planned for at least the first six months.
9. Youth are registered.
10. Unit meetings begin.
11. The unit is installed and the charter is presented at a formal ceremony held at a meeting of the lodge.

DANIEL CARTER BEARD MASONIC SCOUTER AWARD

The Daniel Carter Beard Masonic Scouter Award is a national recognition approved by the Boy Scouts of America and promoted by the Grand Lodges of the United States. It may be presented to any Master Mason who has made significant contributions to youth through Scouting. A member of the Masonic Fraternity may be nominated if the individual is currently a registered Scouter who has displayed outstanding dedication to the Scouting program through:

- Developing Scouting units
- Assisting Masonic lodges in forming units
- Exemplifying the Scout Law and Masonic Virtues
- Recruiting Scouting volunteers
- Strengthening the relationship between Masonry and Scouting

Work accomplishment and dedication, rather than tenure in Scouting, should be the criteria for receiving the award.





THE BADGE OF A MASON

A Mason is given his apron at the Entered Apprentice degree. At that time he is told that the apron is "the badge of a mason" and "...who wears the Lambskin [apron] as a badge of Masonry is continually reminded of that purity of life and conduct which is necessary to obtain admittance into the Celestial Lodge above."

(Ohio Monitor, pps. 11-12)

JESUS

- ▶ As Christians, we know that it is through Jesus, not “purity of life and conduct,” we are saved and go to Heaven.
- ▶ “Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes to the Father, except through Me,” (John 14:6)

THIRD DEGREE RITUAL:

“May the record of your whole life and actions be as pure and spotless as the fair emblem I have placed in your hands tonight [his apron]. And when at that last great day your poor trembling soul stands naked and alone before the Great White Throne, may it be your portion to hear from him who sitteth as the Judge Supreme the welcome words, “Well done, thy good and faithful servant, enter thou into the joy of thy Lord.”

(Tennessee Craftsman/Masonic Handbook, p. 17)

- ❖ The Great White Throne is the Judgement of the damned, according to the Book of Revelation.
- ❖ Why would anyone in their right mind look forward to the Great White Throne Judgement?
- ❖ The only possible reason is they are so deceived they choose to spend eternity with Satan in the Lake of Fire.
- ❖ He loses, according to Rev. 20:10, etc.


ERASMUS DARWIN



Erasmus Darwin: Best known as the grandfather of the biologist Charles Darwin, Erasmus Darwin was a philosopher, poet, scientist and physician. Well informed on all aspects of late 18th-century science and medicine, he had advanced ideas on cosmology and evolution which he recorded in verse of a high quality. "Before coming to Derby in 1788, Dr. [Erasmus] Darwin had been made a Mason in the famous Time Immemorial Lodge of Cannongate Kilwinning, No. 2, of Scotland. "Sir Francis Darwin, one of the Doctor's sons, was made a Mason in Tyrian Lodge, No. 253, at Derby, in 1807 or 1808. His son Reginald was made a mason in Tyrian Lodge in 1804. The name of Charles Darwin does not appear on the rolls of the Lodge but it is very possible that he, like Francis, was a Mason." **Initiated:** 1754, St. David's Lodge No. 36, Edinburgh
